### Summer term

#### Year 13

Vocational courses: all coursework should be completed.

*Depending on what decision is made by the examination board, you may be asked to complete a single assessment in your different subjects during the week beginning 11<sup>th</sup> May*

After this, you should undertake research / wider reading in the area that you are wishing to pursue next year.

#### Year 11

*Depending on what decision is made by the examination board, you may be asked to complete a single assessment in your different subjects during the week beginning 4<sup>th</sup> May*

After this, you should complete the transition work in the 3 subjects (+ 1 reserve) that you are hoping to study next year. All students should complete this, regardless of whether you are choosing to continue your studies in the Lordswood Sixth Form – This work will bridge the gap between GCSE and A Level and will be helpful wherever you study post-16.

***You will have a baseline assessment at the start of next year on the work that has been set. In the case of year 10 and 12 this will be a GCSE paper. This will enable your teachers to understand what you know and what additional support is required.***
